**HORSE**

**WOLF**

The wolf was emblematic of ferocity, treachery, and bloodthirstiness in ancient Israel. They often prowled near sheepfolds at night. Because they possessed the same traits, the tribe of Benjamin was compared to the wolf.

**APE (I.E. "MONKEY")**

The only mention of apes in the Scriptures is in 1 Kings and 2 Chronicles. But the word used for "ape" (*qoph*: word H6971, being of Indian origin) refers to "monkeys" with tails according to Gesenius' Hebrew-Chaldee Lexicon. The importation of exotic animals by nations was a sign of great wealth, signifying the height ancient Israel enjoyed under King Solomon.

"For the king had a fleet of ships of Tarshish at sea with the fleet of Hiram. Once every three years the fleet of ships of Tarshish used to come bringing gold, silver, ivory, apes, and peacocks."

**GAZELLE**

The Hebrew word for this graceful animal is *tsbjy* (word H6643) meaning *beauty* and *honor*. Several Israelite women were named after the gazelle, including Zibiah, the mother of King Joash (2 Chronicles 24:1) and the disciple Tabitha (Acts 9:36).

**GOAT**

The goat was essential to Israelite culture. Beginning with its sacrificial significance, the animal had many uses. The skin, intact with hair, was tanned and used for making containers for milk, oil, water, and wine, and its hair made a strong cloth.
